Thank you for holding our Caribbean brothers and sisters of St. Vincent and the Grenadines in prayer, following the eruption of La Soufriere volcano. By this time we have a clear idea of the inconvenience, disruption and need of the citizens of St. Vincent and the Grenadines.

In respect of the above please take note of the Needs List attached to this correspondence. You are requested to pursue vigorously and urgently, The St. Vincent Relief Fund in Parishes, and/or the collection of the items on the Needs List, to be sent on to St. Vincent via the Office of Disaster Preparedness and Management (ODPM).

We aim to raise \$39, 000. EC dollars (\$100,000. TT approx.) toward this effort. In fact, if each Parish is able to donate \$1000 EC (dollars) we might be able to cover this amount urgently enough to assist the cause and bring some measure of comfort to a people whose lives have been seriously disrupted in a pandemic. Apart from the purchase of materials to be sent, our ongoing conversation with the Bishop of the Windward Islands, will ensure that whatever is collected is put to full use toward the relief effort. The challenges are many and with God's grace we can be instruments of his peace and consolation.
